QMS: 1. Four (4) inch lengths of hair shavings from head of victim near the entrance wound of a gunshot, contained in a sealed small brown paper bag marked W00-3002-B and NMM.

RESULTS: 1. Item 1 was examined microscopically and chemically for the presence of gunshot residues, but except for a very tiny fragment of lead, none were found. The brown hair was coated in various areas with blood, tissue, and bone fragments.

2. The absence of gunpowder residue or singeing or burning of the hair indicates that the distance of the muzzle of the firearm to the victim's head was not contact or near contact, but was held a distance away.

3. When the firearm that was used is submitted to the laboratory, a distance can be determined at which the firearm does not deposit gunshot residues.
